British Values this term is Mutual Respect, learning how we can respect others.






Human Dignity Catholic Social

Geography:



R.E.

This term in RE our topic will be Creation and Covenant.

We will be learning how God created the world and this shows us that God loves us. We will learn how we can get closer to God through prayer and that we can also show our love for God by caring for his creation.





DT

This term we will be making fabric faces. We will create a fabric face containing all of the important facial features of eyes, nose, mouth and hair. We will Use different fabrics to create different effects. We will learn to Create a fabric face using the following skills: Apply glue, cutting, running stitch. safety pinning, taping. Finally, we will say what went well and what could be made better about our fabric faces.

Maths:

In maths, we will learn to count and to recognise numbers to 100. We will count forwards and backwards to 10 and to find missing numbers up to 100. We will be finding 1 more and 1 less than a number up to 100; counting in groups of 10 and trying to make groups of 10. We will also be learning how to order groups of things up to 10.

Science

This term our science is all about the human body. We will label our different body parts, learn what our senses are and label where our senses come from on our bodies.

Music: Our music unit this term will be Hey You! We will listen to, sing and appraise hip-hop songs. We will learn about the differences between pulse and rhythm and playing musical games to develop our pulse-keeping skills.
