



Maths - Oak National Academy

In maths we will begin with composition of multiples of 10. We will progress to counting and representing the numbers 20 to 99.

We will learn to compare, order and partition 2-digit numbers and secure fluency of addition/ subtraction facts within 10. We will continuously explore calculating within 20.

Finally, we will be adding and subtracting ones and tens to and from 2-digit numbers, then grouping objects in different ways and relating to multiplication.

PE:

Thursday will be our PE day this term. We will be exploring team games.

RE

Our RE Unit this term will be Creation and covenant. In this unit we will be exploring God's gift of creation through the story of Noah's Ark and we will be thinking about how we can bring hope to others. We will also be exploring stewardship and the sacrament of Baptism.

Design Technology (DT)

In DT we will explore different types of biscuits and their features. We will then make a plan, discussing how we will bake our own. Once we have baked the biscuits, we will evaluate the overall process and discuss the skills we have used along the way.

English

This term we will be retelling the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and learning how to write letters. We will be embedding our learning of capital letters and full stops, using adjectives, using exclamation marks and question marks.

Music:

In Music we will be learning about pulse, rhythm and pitch. We will have opportunities to find the pulse of music and will learn more about what rhythm is.
