#### **English**

Key Text: The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane

In English, we will write a diary entry of the character Edward's journey using fronted adverbials, the present perfect and expanded noun phrases. We will then write a narrative based on the ending of the story using features such as: inverted commas, paragraphs and modified expanded noun phrases.

In Reading we will be looking at different stories by our author of the term, Roald Dahl tales as well as looking at stories with different endings. We will then explore different VIPER style

## <u>PE</u>

## **History**


#### **RE and RHE**
