In English we will be reading Emma Jane's Aeroplane by Katie Haworth. We will be re-telling the journey adding our own animals and locations. We will be using verbs with the suffix ing at the end to describe our Emma Jane's Aeroplane flies.

British Values, Catholic Social Teaching and Gem Powers:

Science:

We will explore seasonal changes between **winter** and **spring**. We will learn about what happens to the length of the days and nights in spring. We will explore the clothing we wear in spring and draw a tree in spring. We will observe the weather in spring time and collect and record data about temperature, rainfall and wind direction.

This term we will be making a healthy fruit salad. We will be learning where the different fruits come from. We will then choose different fruits to make our fruit salad and use different methods such as chopping and grating to combine the fruit.

R.E.

In R.E. we will be learning about the time Jesus was in the desert and how we remember this during lent. We will also learn about the events of Holy Week and how after being crucified Jesus rose from the dead.

RHE:

In RHE we will be learning how we can safe on-line and who we can speak to if we are worried.

Computing:

We will be learning how to use Maze Explorers in Purple Mash, which is a program to introduce coding to the children. Children will learn to use directional keys to complete challenges. They will learn how to make characters go 'forwards,' 'backwards,' 'left' and 'right.' They will add units of measurement to their work to control movements; how to undo movements that they have made and how to get characters back to their starting points.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be learning about addition and subtraction using numbers up to 20. We will also be looking at the composition of numbers 11-19.
