

English

In English we will be reading the story 'The lonely Beast'. We will be retelling the story with our own beasts. We will be learning to use commas in lists and add the suffixes ful (to adjectives) and ly (to adverbs.)



Design Technology (DT) Making Bunting

In DT, we will be learning what bunting is and how it has been used over time. We will research different styles of bunting. Based on what is liked, children will design, make and evaluate their own bunting, learning to use a template, running and blanket stitch.

Computing

In computing we will learn how to search and read web pages effectively. We will also create music using an online program.

RE/RHE

In RHE we will be learning about our feelings and times that we have felt different emotions. We will be thinking about how we should act when we feel cross or angry. Our RE unit will be 'Desert to Garden.' We will be able to recognize that lent is a time for reconciliation and forgiveness. We will make connections with the simple belief that God always forgives us.

Science

This term we will be exploring living things and their habitats. We will be learning what animals need to stay alive and how where they live (their habitats) are important in animals staying alive. We will also be learning about the diets of different living things.
